Enrollment

- ▶ Funded for 192 children
 - ▶ Currently have 169 enrolled. We have not been fully enrolled this year
- ▶ Cumulative enrollment this year: 236
 - ▶ 104 three year olds
 - ▶ 132 four year olds
- ▶ 70 children in their second year with us
- ▶ 2 children in their third year with us

- ▶ 146 children on waitlist—all but 13 are ineligible

Eligibility

- ▶ 95—Income at or below 100% of federal poverty line
- ▶ 5—Recipient of Public Assistance
- ▶ 19—Foster care
- ▶ 76—Homeless
- ▶ 32—Income 101-130% of federal poverty line
- ▶ 8—Other

***these numbers represent the cumulative enrollment

Special Services

- ▶ 26 children with diagnosed disabilities (Required to have 19)
 - ▶ 10—S/L impairment
 - ▶ 3—Autism
 - ▶ 13—Developmental Delay
- ▶ 39 children receiving on-site Speech/Language services
- ▶ 18 children receiving on-site Occupational Therapy services
- ▶ 31 children receiving outside mental health support
 - ▶ On-Site mental health specialist working with 15 children with behavior support plans
