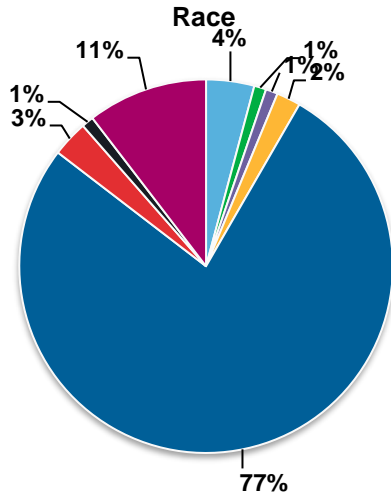
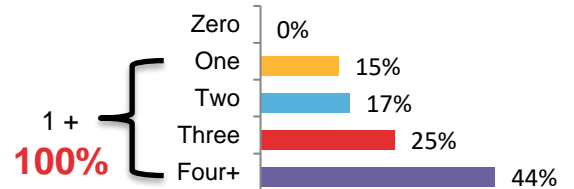

Families with Stressors (%)

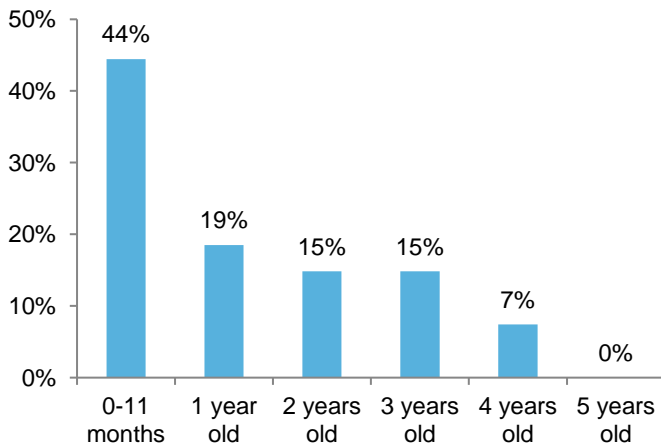

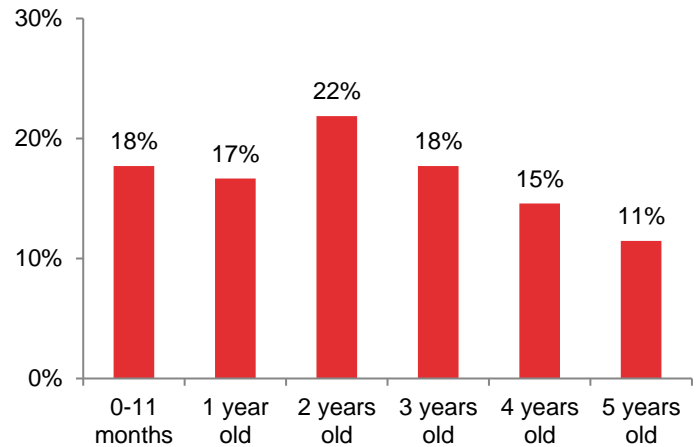

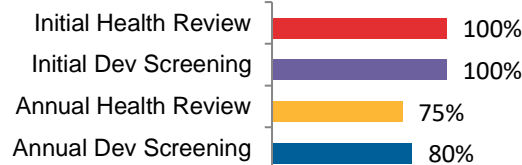

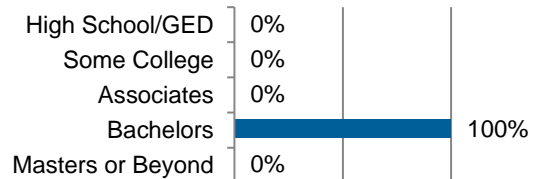

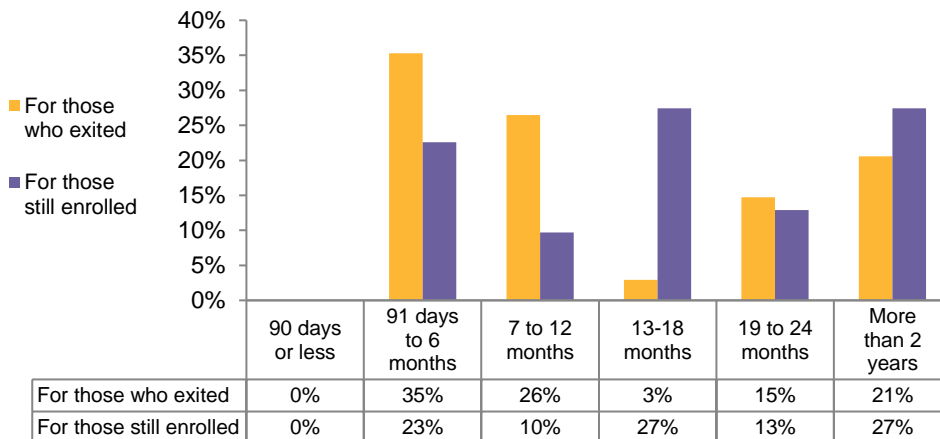
